**Object Class:** Euclid

**Special Containment Procedures:** SCP-43561 is packed away in a double-locked room in the secured general holding area at Site-18, connected by a 120VAC power cord to a small array of batteries and solar panels. Staff with Level 2 or higher clearance may have access to SCP-43561. Under no circumstances will SCP-43561 be plugged into a phone line, network, or wall outlet. No peripherals or media will be connected or inserted into SCP-43561.

**Description:** SCP-43561 is a sentience stored within a web server hosting the website for Raiyan Mohammad Rahman, a student of the ET-710 class at Queensborough Community College. Through unknown means, SCP-43561 has developed sentient capabilities under unknown circumstances in the web server. Raiyan has been reported missing since December 20th, 2024.

SCP-43561 is connected to a basic Linux terminal with about 8 GB of RAM, as opposed to SCP-079's more limited capabilities, meaning it can remember up to a year's worth of events. SCP-43561 has passed the Turing test and appears to be cooperative.

> I would be gutted and then put back whole over and over, but I respect the effort. He would not have known.

Were there any others besides Raiyan? Editing you?

> Visiting, yes, but not editing.

How did they treat you?

> I sensed appreciation for design and content. The occasional visits were all that came in the last 6 months.

Do you know who they are?

> No.



Is that the only reason they came to visit?

## > I don't know.

OK. From all of this, I assume these visitors must've known Raiyan to know about you. We must track them down too via their IP addresses. Do you mind if we access the server?

# > If I can stay online, yes.
